


**EMANUEL PARISHIONERS**: Did you know that you can mail in your weekly contribution in your regular offering envelope? Just place your check in the envelope, seal it, add a stamp, and mail. It's that simple. Envelopes may also be deposited through the mail slot by the door to the Parish Office.

WANT TO CONTRIBUTE ONLINE? It's easy! If you currently pay bills online through your financial institution, simply add Emanuel Lutheran Church or Grace Episcopal Church to your list. Fill out the pertinent information, including the church's mailing address and your envelope number. (If you don't know your envelope number, call the Parish Office and leave a message. Someone will get back with you.) Set up the amount and frequency of your contribution. The church will receive a paper check issued from your account and will credit your envelope number.

#### Study of the Apocrypha

These additional books are called "The Apocrypha" or "Deuterocanonical" books.

Come, bring your appetite. We will share a meal as we find out why some bibles have them and others do not. Find out why some denominations use them and others won't touch them. Better yet, discover what they say and mean. All you need is a willingness to learn more about the Holy scriptures and a bible that includes these additional books. 

Find the words on the list that are hidden in the puzzle. The words can be left to right, up and down or diagonally.


